Assessment Methodology

- a) Mandatory units will be assessed using a 20 question multiple choice paper for units 201 and 202 and a 10 question multiple choice paper for 203 which can be taken 'on-demand' and will be externally set and marked resulting in either a fail or a pass.
- b) The optional unit will be assessed using a 20 question multiple choice paper which can be taken 'on-demand' and will be externally set and marked resulting in either a fail or pass/merit/distinction outcome and by completing an externally provided observation checklist to confirm that the skills required for the unit have been met.
